CLINICAL SERVICES

We offer psychological and nursing services 24/7!! We have:

- * Individualized Behavior Plans
- * Individualized Individual Plans
- * Individualized Nursing Care Plans
- * Support For Behaviorally Challenged Individuals
- * Blood Pressure & Glucose Monitoring
- * Monitoring of Special Dietary Needs

Behavioral support plans are developed for each individual, integrating behavioral, and therapeutic treatment through comprehensive and integrated clinical services.

SERVICES

Community Living

Our individuals live in homes across Maryland and are supported in activities of daily living, functional life skills, personal care skills, and basic health care.

Individual Support Services

We customize skills training based on our individuals' preferences, interests, needs, and as stipulated by their individual treatment plans.

Behavioral Support Services

All behavioral support services are individually-focused and developed. Services may include clinical consultation in interdisciplinary team meetings.

Nursing

Registered Nurses are available 24/7 to administer medications and conduct nursing assessments. All staff members are trained in CPR and first aid.
